

The number of ported mobile numbers in the first quarter of 2019

The number of mobile telephone subscriptions ported from operator to another exceeded 11,8 million.

Suomen Numerot Numpac Oy provides services to the telecommunications operators required under the number porting regulation and other legislation.

Numpac's range of services includes Number Portability Services for mobile and fixed communications networks, Call Routing Services, Numpac Query Service for mobile telephone service providers for finding the current mobile operator and information service for ported numbers intended for consumers.

In the first quarter of 2019, the number of ported mobile telephone numbers was 211.065. The number of ported mobile numbers decreased 32.143 times i.e. -15,2 per cent compared to the first quarter of 2018. Overall already 11,848 million mobile telephone subscriptions have been ported from operator to another in Finland.

The number of ported fixed network telephone numbers increased in the first quarter of 2019 being 19.165, which is 12.251 more than at the same time in 2018.

The number portability in Finland is executed by Master-database which is administered by Numpac. Master-database is a joint database for every ported mobile numbers and fixed network numbers. Calls are routed in the telecommunications networks by the information of the ported numbers in the Master-database.
