

The number of ported numbers in the first quarter of 2023

The number of mobile telephone subscriptions ported from operator to operator exceeded 14.9 million

Suomen Numerot Numpac Oy provides services to the telecommunications operators that are required under the number porting regulation and other related legislation.

Numpac's range of services includes, for example, Number Portability Services for mobile and fixed communications networks, Call Routing Services, Number Query Service for mobile telephone service providers for identifying the current mobile operator and ported number Information Services for consumers.

In the first quarter of 2023, the number of ported mobile telephone numbers was 144.869. In comparison to the first quarter of 2022, the number of ported mobile numbers decreased by 50.256 (-25,8 per cent). Overall, already over 14,9 million mobile telephone subscriptions have been ported from operator to operator in Finland.

The number of ported fixed network telephone numbers increased in the first quarter of 2023 to 7.256, which is 2614 more (+56,2 per cent) when compared to the first quarter of 2022.

Number porting is implemented with the Master System, a database software managed by Numpac. The system contains all ported mobile and fixed communications network numbers. The Master System's data on ported numbers is used for routing calls in telecommunications networks.
